

Monday – May 15, 2006

The regular meeting of the Board of Embalmers and Funeral Directors was held in the Riffe Center located in Columbus. President, Robert L. Shank, Sr., called the meeting to order at 1:07 P.M. Wisby, Inspector; Jennifer Baugess, Administrative Assistant; Linda Clark, Certification/License Examiner; Lena Wright, Administrative Assistant, and Ann Cunningham, Executive Director. Mark and Monica Hall were present.

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Director's Report

Ms. Cunningham reported that Mr. Hadley monitored the Board's examinations on April 26, 2006 along with Mrs. Baugess. Mr. Hadley received per diem and reimbursement for allowable travel expenses.

Mr. DeJohn, Mr. Hadley, Mr. Primm and Mr. Shank staffed the Board's booth at the Ohio Funeral Directors Annual Convention May 10-11-12, 2006 in Columbus, and they received per diem and allowable travel expenses. Mrs. Baugess, Ms. Cunningham, Mr. Savage and Mr. Wisby also worked during exhibit hours to answer questions, take comments from licensees and distribute individualized envelope to licensees eligible for a 50-year continuing education exemption. Zach Dunlap, Assistant Attorney General toured the exhibition hall on Friday.

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Mr. DeJohn and Mr. Savage will represent the Board on the semi-annual law seminar conducted by the Pittsburgh Institute of Mortuary Science on August 23, 2006.

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Board Members were reminded that Mr. Wisby and Ms. Cunningham will represent the Board at the May 17, 2006 meeting of the Greater Montgomery County Funeral Directors Association in Dayton.

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Ms. Cunningham reported that the Ohio Department of Health, Bureau of Vital Statistics requested access to funeral home information for Bureau's Electronic Death Registration System. This is in addition to their original request for licensee information.

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Am. Sub. House Bill 426, Right of Disposition and House Bill 484, funeral protest, are still under consideration by the Ohio Legislature

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Ms. Cunningham reported that she attended meetings for the Mass Fatality Committee in conjunction with the Ohio Emergency Management Agency. Also, she attended a meeting for the Boards and Commissions, on Pandemic Preparedness that requires a plan in the event the State of Ohio closes the Riffe Center for ninety days. The last meeting included instructions for creating a transition paper for the new administration. All Boards and Commissions will combine their respective transition papers into one three-ring binder using the same format.



The Board Members reviewed various newspaper articles related to the funeral profession.
