

Monday – December 17, 2007

Prior to the Board meeting, the Board Members hosted the staff to a holiday luncheon at the Doubletree. 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Ms Cunningham reported that she along with Mrs. Baugess and Mr. Hadley attended a meeting with other interested parties chaired by Peter Voderberg, aide to Senator Tim Schaffer on December 11 to discuss S.B. 196 concerning preneed. Mr. Hadley received per diem and was reimbursed for allowable travel expenses

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Board Members reviewed a copy of a Press Release from the Ohio Department of Insurance titled "Insurance Department Alerts Seniors to Predatory Annuities Sales Practices."

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Board Members reviewed a copy of a news article from the Columbus Dispatch concerning H. B. 104, Criminal Background Checks, and titled "State Lawmakers: No Criminal Checks on Us." With the enactment of this bill, the Board will be able to require criminal background checks on initial applicants.
